


An Annual Report (2023–2024)







Our Mission

- Develop intelligent systems that go beyond pattern recognition by enabling them to:
 - Distinguish genuine causal relationships from spurious ones (causality),
 - Recognize the limits of their own knowledge (uncertainty),
 - Earn and maintain human trust (human-centric design),
 - Learn to collaborate effectively with one another (collective intelligence).
- Achieving this vision require a seamless integration of data, people, and Al.
- Our approach is interdisciplinary, combining insights from statistics,
 computer science, machine learning, and economics.

Our Achievements

- ~16 publications (7 conferences, 4 journals, 5 pre-prints)
 - o 1 Oral at NeurIPS, 1 Oral at AAAI, 1 Spotlight at NeurIPS, 1 Spotlight at ICML, etc
- Anurag and Kiet participated in the MLSS 2024 in Okinawa, Japan
- Alan received a job offer from NTU, Singapore

 - Initiate collaborations with Rebekka's group




2025 – Breaking Through
